Your personal data shall be incorporated into an automatic filing system by virtue of Organic Law 15/1999, dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, related to Personal Data Protection and may be used solely for the purpose of management of the anchoring, navigation, diving data base belonging to the Galician Atlantic Islands National Park. Applicants may at any time exercise their right to access, rectify, cancel and oppose to their data inclusion by sending in a written request to the office of the Galician Atlantic Islands National Park. In case you require navigation permission for a **vessel**, kindly send us the pertinent duly filled in application form (downloadable from [www.iatlanticas.es](http://www.iatlanticas.es)) together with the following documents:

1. Photocopy of ID card of vessel owner.
2. Photocopy of Spanish Maritime Registration or similar document that specifies vessel characteristics and name of owner.

If navigation permission application is for a **kayak**, a **canoe** or any other floating artefact described in Royal Decree 1435/2010, dated 5<sup>th</sup> November, then only application form together with the ID card/ passport of user needs to be sent in. Such artefacts do not need any anchoring permission. Should you want to take them to the beach, these must be taken upshore to a place where they are not a nuisance to other beach users. Never leave them on the bank of the entry channel or on top of the dune area.

For **jet skis**, documents required are: application form, photocopy of owner's ID card or passport and jet ski registration document.

Permission will be sent to applicants to their address indicated on the application form, once all required documentation has been received. Such permission must be carried onboard at all times.

**Renewal of permits is automatic upon expiry. There is no need to send in a renewal application.**

Kindly inform us of any changes in vessel ownership, registration, name and personal data of owner.

Application for anchoring permission can be done through the internet without any need for sending application through the office. The procedure is as follows:

Anchoring permission (even for the same day) can be applied for through the website [www.iatlanticas.es](http://www.iatlanticas.es) and can be directly downloaded via the anchoring management program. It can be done as follows:

When you connect for the very first time, User name will be asked which will be vessel owner ID number (number, space and capital letter) and the password which is the navigation permission number. After that, the system will suggest that you change password, and such new password will be used thereafter.

This procedure shall also provide you with access to vessel and owner's data. The lower part of the screen has a drop-down menu showing the archipelagos. Kindly select one and provide details of number of passengers. For dates, there is another drop-down menu which displays the following seven calendar days from which you can select three. A thirty day calendar will appear in the drop-down menu if your application is made between the 15<sup>th</sup> of September and the 14<sup>th</sup> of June. It allows you to choose up to a maximum of ten days. Permissions are valid on a daily basis and these must therefore be printed and carried onboard the vessel. These can be downloaded from three to ten days prior to date of use.
